Bali 2002

Full series drop on ITVX on Thursday 16th March

An inspiring four-part drama that explores how everyday heroes from Bali, Australia and beyond brought hope from despair during the 2002 Bali bombings.

On the 12th of October, 2002, the island paradise of Bali was shattered by a terrorist attack on two of Kuta Beach's busiest nightclubs - both the local Balinese and international tourists scrambled to escape, rescue the injured, and comfort the dying. Australian and Indonesian authorities not only mobilised to evacuate survivors and identify victims, but to hunt down those responsible - amidst this chaos, heroes arose to defy the odds from the most unlikely places and cultures united in the search for healing, justice, and meaning. The series features a stellar cast led by AACTA Award-winner Rachel Griffiths, Richard Roxburgh, Claudia Jessie, Sean Keenan, Ewen Leslie and Arka Das.


