

Mr Bates vs the Post Office Monday-Thursday, 9pm 1st-4th January ITV1

This drama series tells the story of one of the greatest miscarriages of justice in British legal history and its effect on innocent subpostmasters and postmistresses.

When mysterious financial losses start to appear in village Post Office tills, subpostmasters Alan Bates, Jo Hamilton, Noel Thomas and Lee Castleton seek help but end up leading a fightback against a tide of accusations, harassment and prosecutions.









Mr Bates vs the Post Office: The Real Story Thursday, 10.45pm 4th January ITV1

This documentary tells the story of the widest miscarriage of justice in British legal history when hundreds of subpostmasters were accused of crimes over 20 years.

As an accompaniment to the drama Mr Bates vs The Post Office, this film reveals how hundreds of subpostmasters were accused of theft over a 20-year period - some were sent to prison, over 700 were given criminal convictions, and livelihoods were trashed.



FA Cup Live: Tottenham Hotspur v Burnley Friday, 7.30pm 5th January ITV1

Coverage of Emirates FA Cup 2023-24 Third Round action as Ange Postecoglou gets a first taste of the Cup with his Tottenham Hotspur team entertaining Burnley.

Spurs have endured something of a sticky spell of late after a promising start to the season, but the eight-time winners have a long-standing love affair with the Cup and will fancy their chances of going on a strong run as they take on a hard-fighting Burnley side.

Alison Hammond in at the Rich End: The Riviera Tuesday, 9pm 2nd January ITVBe

Alison Hammond is on a mission to find out what makes the super-rich tick as she samples eye-watering opulence first-hand in this one-off special documentary.

Alison travels across the legendary French Riviera - one of the most expensive places to live on the planet - and is ready to be thrown in at the rich end and surrounded by those with next-level wealth. Will she fit in here, and will she ultimately even want to anyway?







Carry On Weekend Saturday, from 10.50am Sunday, from 11.20am 30th & 31st December ITV3

Celebrate one of British cinema's most endearing film series with a whole weekend dedicated to its classic brand of humour and seemingly endless run of innuendoes.
