New shows you won't want to miss

The Day of the Jackal

This contemporary reimagining of the iconic thriller stars Academy, Tony and BAFTA award-winner **Eddie Redmayne** (*Broadway's current CABARET Revival, The Good Nurse, The Theory of Everything*) as The Jackal, an unrivalled and highly elusive lone assassin, and **Lashana Lynch** (*Bob Marley: One Love, The Woman King, No Time To Die*) as Bianca, a tenacious MI6 agent in a relentless, global pursuit to catch him.

The 10-part adaptation is based on the seminal novel by Frederick Forsyth and subsequent award-winning 1973 film from Universal Pictures. The series is produced by Downton Abbey and The Last Kingdom producers Carnival Films, part of Universal International Studios, a division of Universal Studio Group, and was commissioned by Sky Studios and Peacock.

The series is written and adapted by Ronan Bennett, creator and writer of the critically acclaimed Top Boy. Internationally award-winning Director Brian Kirk (*Game of Thrones, Luther, Boardwalk Empire*) is the lead director.

Sweetpea

In a deviously twisted coming-of-'rage' story, **Ella Purnell** (*Yellowjackets*, *Fallout*) stars as Rhiannon: a quiet wallflower on a darkly comedic and intoxicating journey of self-discovery, with deadly consequences.

Rhiannon Lewis doesn't make much of an impression - people walk past her in the street without a second glance. She's continually overlooked for a promotion at work, the guy she likes won't commit, and her dad is really, really sick. Then everything in her life turns upside down. Rhiannon is pushed over the edge, and loses control. Suddenly the wallflower is gone, and in its place is a young woman capable of anything... Rhiannon's life transforms as she steps into a new, intoxicating power, but can she keep her killer secret?

Further casting alongside Purnell boasts an array of exciting British talent, including **Nicôle Lecky** (*Mood*, *Sense8*) as Julia, **Jon Pointing** (*Big Boys*, *Smothered*) as Craig, **Calam Lynch** (*Bridgerton*) as AJ, **Leah Harvey** (*Foundation*) as Marina. Also starring **Jeremy Swift** (*Ted Lasso*) as Norman and **Dustin Demri-Burns** (*Slow Horses*) as Jeff.

The series is adapted from C.J. Skuse's novel of the same name by writer and Executive Producer Kirstie Swain (*Pure*), and written by Kirstie Swain, and Krissie Ducker (*Killing Eve*), alongside Laura Jayne Tunbridge and Selina Lim (*Sex Education*, *Hanna*). The series will be directed by award-winning director Ella Jones (*The Baby*, *Back To Life*), who also serves as Executive Producer.

Black Widow

Black Widow follows the decade-long police investigation into one of Britain's most dangerous female murderers. Over 20 years, Dena Thompson who was known as 'The Black Widow', carried out a sustained campaign of fraud, deception, bigamy and murder. Using Lonely Hearts columns to lure a succession of husbands and dozens of lovers into her life, she was able to coerce them into giving up their life's savings, their homes, their families and their freedom based on her bizarre but convincing stories.

Dena was finally caught in 2003 and convicted for murder, but after 19 years behind bars, she has been released from prison, and her victims are still struggling to understand what happened to them. This 3 x 60" series includes first-hand testimony from those affected, with exclusive access to her first husband - who ended up homeless believing he was on the run from the mafia.

Matlock stars Emmy and Academy Award winner **Kathy Bates** as Madeline “Matty” Matlock, a brilliant septuagenarian who achieved success in her younger years and decides to rejoin the work force at a prestigious law firm where she uses her unassuming demeanor and wily tactics to win cases. Matty is assigned to Olympia (**Skye P. Marshall**), a senior attorney and key rainmaker with a thirst for justice, while Olympia’s ex-husband, Julian (**Jason Ritter**), the son of the head of the firm, is intrigued by Matty and her clever skills. As Matty endeavors to establish herself in her new high-stakes world, she works alongside the firm’s younger associates – the charismatic Billy (**David Del Rio**) and the uber ambitious Sarah (**Leah Lewis**).

The Frost Tapes (w/t)

The Frost Tapes (w/t) charts almost half a century of dizzying social, political, and cultural change through the eyes of the one man who had a front-row seat to it all: Sir David Frost. A Sky Studios production, co-produced with Paradine Productions and White Horse Pictures, the series is made in collaboration with Frost's son, Wilfred, with each episode anchored around Frost's interviews with one key personality, providing a springboard into deeply relevant subject matters.

Drawing from Frost's archive of more than 10,000 era-defining interviews, many of which have been lost for a generation, the documentary takes viewers on an immersive journey through the most important moments of the late 20th century via Frost's personal and revealing conversations with the protagonists, with striking parallels to today.

This archive footage is supplemented by interviews with an extraordinary list of new contributors including **Michael Sheen, Liam Neeson, Joanna Lumley, Khalilah Ali** and **Tony Blair** who help uncover Frost's incredible life and career as one of the nation's most renowned television hosts and journalists.
