This starry version of the hit game show sees famous faces pair up and go head-to-head in the fast-paced wordplay game in a bid to win big money for their charities.

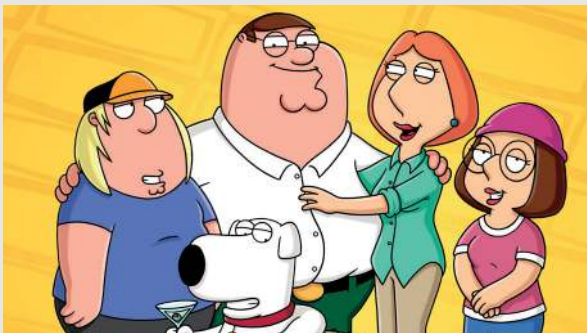
